**Reconstitution and Storage:** Store freeze-dried powder at 2-8°C. When ready to use, rehydrate with 1.1 ml dH<sub>2</sub>O and centrifuge if not clear. Product is stable for about 6 weeks at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid. Prepare working dilution fresh each day. For extended storage after rehydration, aliquot and freeze at -70°C or below. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Alternatively, add an equal volume of glycerol (ACS grade or better) for a final concentration of 50%, and store at -20°C as a liquid. Note: adding glycerol reduces the stated protein concentration and dilution range by one-half. ***Expiration date:*** one year from date of rehydration. The expiration date may be extended if test results are acceptable for the intended use.

**Purity:** The antibody was purified from antisera by immunoaffinity chromatography using antigens coupled to agarose beads.

**Antibody Specificity:** Based on immunoelectrophoresis and/or ELISA, the antibody reacts with both rat IgG and IgM. It also reacts with the light chains of other rat immunoglobulins. No antibody was detected against non-immunoglobulin serum proteins. The antibody has been tested by ELISA and/or solid-phase adsorbed to ensure minimal cross-reaction with human, bovine, and horse serum proteins, but it may cross-react with immunoglobulins from other species.
